You will be contacted the week of Earth Day with your space number.

Rules and Guidelines

- Set up hours are from 7:00 am to 9:00 am.
- Festival takes place **RAIN or SHINE.**
- Vendor traffic will not be permitted in the festival area after 9 am.
- Vendor parking for **all** vehicles will be in a designated area.
- Vehicles are not allowed to remain at your assigned site.
- Breakdown is not permitted prior to 4 pm.
- Space must be staffed at all times.
- Vendors cannot sell or give away animals (including fish) or helium filled balloons.
- Flea market items will not be allowed.
- Exhibitors in violation of festival rules will be asked to leave without a refund.
- You will be asked to stop the sale or distribution of any items that do not meet ACUA Earth Day vendor criteria as stated in this letter.

ATTENTION FOOD VENDORS

The ACUA suggests that you do not use styrofoam products.
