Recycling and Trash Collection just got easier! Recycling will now be collected every other week on the same day as trash.

Trash collection days remain the same:

- TUESDAY:** Rt. 54 N. of Weymouth Rd to Hamilton and Folsom border. Newtonville and Buena Acres included.
- WEDNESDAY:** Area bordered by Folsom, Monroe & Franklin Twp., Buena Boro and Rt. 54. Collings Lakes, Cains Mill, Jackson & Unexpected Rds. and Lake Ann Estates
- THURSDAY:** Weymouth Rd, Rt. 54 S., Rt. 40, Cedar, Llewlylyn, Main, & Old Landis Aves. Country Club area, Richland Village & Petrini Gardens
- FRIDAY:** Tuckahoe Rd and South to Cumberland County & Hamilton Twp, includes Milmay & E. Vineland

***Please do not use plastic bags for your recyclables & yard waste!**

Yard Waste: (leaves, brush, grass, clean wood) Place loose material in labeled cans or kraft bags; bags should not exceed 50 lbs. **Brush/branches:** must be bundled & tied with twine. Should not exceed 4 ft. in length or 8 inches in diameter.

Bulky Waste

Up to two bulky items (including furniture, TVs, electronics, carpeting, metals and appliances) and two non-commercial tires (removed from rims) per trash day will be collected weekly on the same day as trash collection.
No construction waste.

Single-Stream Recycling

Atlantic County's recycling program is now a single-stream program. The following items can be placed in the same container. No separation is necessary.

- Newspapers
- Brown Paper Bags
- Paperback Books
- Junk Mail / Envelopes
- Pizza Boxes
- Computer Paper
- Other boxes, including food, cereal, shoe, gift boxes
- Aluminum Cans
- Glass Bottles & Jars
- Paint Cans (empty) lids removed
- Any plastic container with these numbers:
- Magazines/Catalogs
- Telephone Books
- Hardback Books (covers removed)
- Egg Cartons (paper)
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Soda/Beer Cartons
- Aerosol Cans (empty)
- Steel (tin) Cans lids removed



Please DO NOT recycle these items curbside:

- any plastic container without a number
- styrofoam
- plastic bags (some supermarkets accept these for recycling)
- waxed coated material, such as milk cartons
