Please **DO NOT** recycle these items curbside:

- any plastic container without a number
- styrofoam
- plastic bags (some supermarkets accept these for recycling)
- waxed coated material, such as milk cartons

Bulky Waste Two items per trash day including furniture and carpeting. No construction waste, TVs or electronics. Call Public Works for metals/appliance pick ups, 822-5759.

Electronics ACUA does not accept electronics. State law prohibits electronics from being disposed of as trash. First, contact Public Works to inquire if they have a collection program. If not, visit www.acua.com/electronics for other options.

Latex Paint Latex paint is not hazardous waste and dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. Go to www.acua.com/paint for more information.

Large/Rigid Plastics Many other plastic items are recyclable at no charge through the ACUA's **large rigid/plastic drop-off**. www.acua.com/rigidplastics.

Rechargeable Batteries Bring rechargeable batteries to ACUA's Household Hazardous Waste Days or look for a local drop off location at www.call2recycle.org. *Alkaline batteries can be put in the trash since they contain minimal or no mercury.*
