

Step #1

Determine if the product is household hazardous waste

Items accepted include:

- all cleaning products
- all insecticides
- pool chemicals
- all fuels
- auto care products
- chemistry sets
- photographic chemicals
- oil-based paint (a flammable material)
- 1 lb. propane cylinders **ONLY**
- compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs) and other mercury containing items
- non-rechargeable household dry chemical fire extinguishers
- rechargeable batteries
- latex paint*

* Latex paint is not a household hazardous waste item. If the can has paint, please add clay based kitty litter or speedy dry to the can and dispose of the dried paint in your trash can. Please recycle empty paint cans.

Items NOT accepted:

- explosives
- radioactive materials
- asbestos
- smoke detectors (return to manufacturer)
- medications
- pentachlorophenol
- gas cylinders / propane tanks
- 2, 4, 5, Silvex
- commercial or industrial hazardous waste
- rechargeable fire extinguishers
- unidentifiable materials
- ammunition
- dioxin
- PCB's

When in doubt treat the product as household hazardous waste.

Step #2

Safely package and transport household hazardous waste

To safely package and transport household hazardous waste please keep all products in original containers and wrap leaking containers in newspaper and place in a box or garbage container.

- Place items securely in a box for transport.
- Keep chemicals that could react with one another separated and do not leave them in hot, unventilated areas for long periods of time.
- Place CFLs and other mercury containing items in a sealed plastic bag or its original container to prevent breakage.

PLEASE NOTE:



Individual container sizes cannot exceed five gallons and individual containers will not be returned. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Step #3

Bring household hazardous waste to ACUA Park at 6700 Delilah Rd., Egg Harbor Twp.

Please drop off materials between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m.

Household Hazardous Waste Checklist

1. Proof of Atlantic County residency is **REQUIRED**. Do you have a driver's license, tax bill, etc. with you?
2. Did you review the household hazardous waste list of acceptable items and are you only bringing materials that are accepted?
3. The maximum quantity of household hazardous waste is 30 gallons and/or 200 lbs. dry weight per household.
4. Individual container sizes cannot exceed 5 gallons. **NO EXCEPTIONS. CONTAINERS WILL NOT BE RETURNED.**

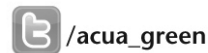
