RE: Customer Access Tags

Dear Sir/Madame;

All outside haulers will be issued gate passes within the next few weeks for each of their trucks that will enter the ACUA facility. These gate passes are RFID tags act like EZ Passes at our front gate. The front gate has been connected to a computer which will read the gate pass, and, if you are an authorized, paid to date customer, it will open the gate and log the truck in when you entered the facility.

The passes are being issued as part of a larger program to: secure the plant and provide for future automatic logging and eventually billing of our commercial customers.

Within the next month or so a new gate system will be installed. This system will consist of an Access and Egress gate that will cover half of the road so that it will not take as long to open the gate. The gates will be closed at all times during week.

The tags will be permanently attached to an outer, passenger side of the vehicle. The tag will automatically be read as you drive on the right hand side of the road. There will not be a charge for the first tag. Any lost or damaged tags will require a \$50 replacement fee.

The tags will be affixed to your vehicle during your next delivery by an ACUA employee. All vehicles you anticipate to be used at the ACUA plant need to be tagged. The telephone will only be available as a backup to the passes not a substitute for a tag.
