## Recycling Guidelines

Please do not use plastic bags for your recyclables!

### Paper

Please place the following materials in a brown paper grocery bag or tie with twine.

- Catalogs
- Newspapers
- Magazines
- Junk mail
- Envelopes
- Computer paper
- Brown paper bags
- Telephone books
- Paperback books
- Shredded paper



\*Plastic bags are not accepted as part of our recycling program, but may be dropped off at a participating supermarket. Reuse bags or use canvas or cloth bags as an alternative.

### Corrugated Cardboard

Corrugated cardboard (wavy material between two cardboard sheets) must be flattened, stacked in bundles & tied with twine.



### Cans & Bottles



Please rinse and place the following materials together in your recycling bucket:

- Glass bottles & jars
- Aluminum cans
- Steel (tin) cans
- Aerosol cans (empty) – lids removed
- Paint cans (empty) – lids removed
- All plastic bottles & jars – lids removed (no plastic tubs, cups, toys or bags)

### Rechargeable Batteries

Rechargeable batteries can be found in cordless power tools, cellular and cordless phones, lap top computers and camcorders. Please place the batteries in a clear plastic bag and place on top of your recycling bucket.

Alkaline batteries can be put in the trash since they contain minimal or no mercury.
