DISPOSAL INFORMATION

Bulky Waste: 2 items per trash day including furniture & mattresses. Carpet must be cut in 4' lengths, rolled & tied (1 roll = 1 bulk item).

No construction waste, TVs, electronics, metals or appliances.

Electronics: Electronics must be dropped off at the Public Works Yard, 3605 Bayshore Avenue. ACUA does not accept electronics.

Latex Paint: Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. acua.com/paint

Batteries: Alkaline batteries can go in the trash. Rechargeable, silver-oxide, lithium-ion, nickel-cadmium, & lead-acid batteries should be taken to a HHW drop-off. acua.com/hhw

Shredded Paper: Cannot be recycled curbside, but can be brought to ACUA's Recycling Drop-off in EHT. acua.com/rcdropoffs

Metals & Appliances: May be dropped off at Brigantine Public Works at 3605 Bayshore Avenue. Call (609) 266-7800 for details.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Sector A — Streets south of and including 25th Street South.

Sector B — Streets north of and including 24th Street South.

Includes: leaves, grass, brush, branches and Christmas trees

- No bamboo, cornstalks, reeds, seagrass, or hay/straw bales.
- No plastic bags.
- Use kraft bags or properly marked containers.
- Bags or containers should not exceed 50 lbs.
- Brush/branches must be tied with twine.
- Brush/branches should not exceed 4' in length or 8" in diameter.
