Includes: leaves, grass, brush, branches, and Christmas trees

Do not place curbside more than 24 hours before pick-up.

- No bamboo, cornstalks, reeds, seagrass, or hay/straw bales. No plastic bags. Use kraft bags or properly marked containers.
- Bags or containers should not exceed 50 lbs.
- Brush/branches must be tied with twine.
- Brush/branches should not exceed 4' in length or 8" in diameter. Sector A: East side of Shore Road to the bay; North Curran to White Horse

Pike, South White Horse Pike to California Avenue

Sector B: West side of Shore Road to Galloway Township border, Upland Avenue to the White Horse Pike
