## DO NOT RECYCLE

## DISPOSAL INFORMATION

**Bulky Waste:** 2 items per trash day including furniture & mattresses. Carpet must be cut into 4' lengths, rolled & tied (1 roll = 1 bulk item).

**No metals, electronics, construction waste or televisions.**

**Metals:** Call Public Works for metals/appliance pick up (609) 646-0664.  
**Electronics:** Neither ACUA nor Public Works accepts electronics. Visit [acua.com/electronics](http://acua.com/electronics) for recycling/disposal options.

**Latex Paint:** Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. [acua.com/paint](http://acua.com/paint)

**Batteries:** Alkaline batteries can go in the trash. Rechargeable, lithium-ion, nickel-cadmium, silver-oxide and lead-acid batteries should be taken to a HHW drop-off. [acua.com/hhw](http://acua.com/hhw)

**Shredded Paper:** Cannot be recycled curbside, but can be brought to ACUA's Recycling Drop-off in EHT. [acua.com/rcdropoffs](http://acua.com/rcdropoffs)

## YARD WASTE INFORMATION

**Includes: leaves, grass, brush, branches, and Christmas trees**  
Do not place curbside more than 24 hours before pick-up.

- No bamboo, cornstalks, reeds, seagrass, or hay/straw bales.
- No plastic bags. Use kraft bags or properly marked containers.
- Bags or containers should not exceed 50 lbs.
- Brush/branches must be tied with twine.
- Brush/branches should not exceed 4' in length or 8" in diameter.

**Sector A:** East side of Shore Road to the bay; North Curran to White Horse Pike, South White Horse Pike to California Avenue

**Sector B:** West side of Shore Road to Galloway Township border, Upland Avenue to the White Horse Pike

**NOTE:** The City of Absecon offers curbside loose leaf collection in April, Nov. & Dec.
