DISPOSAL INFORMATION

BULKY WASTE: One (1) item per trash day including furniture and mattresses. Carpet must be cut into 4' lengths, rolled and tied (1 roll=1 bulk item). *No metals, construction waste, televisions or electronics.*

ELECTRONICS: Call Public Works to schedule a collection.

METALS & APPLIANCES: Call Public Works to schedule a collection.

LATEX PAINT: Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. *acua.com/paint*

BATTERIES: Alkaline batteries can go in the trash. Rechargeable, lithium-ion, nickel-cadmium, silver-oxide and lead-acid batteries should be taken to a Household Hazardous Waste drop-off. *acua.com/hhw*

SHREDDED PAPER: Cannot be recycled curbside, but can be brought to ACUA's Recycling Drop-off in EHT. *acua.com/rcdropoffs*

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DROP-OFF

- Visit acua.com/hhw for 2024 dates and details.
- Proof of residency is required driver's license, tax bill, etc.
- Containers will not be returned, no exceptions. Bring items in a throwaway container (such as a cardboard box).

Maximum quantity is 20 gallons and/or 200 lbs. dry weight.

- Container sizes cannot exceed 5 gallons. No exceptions.
- NO materials from commercial establishments.
