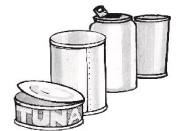
GLASS

METALS

Aluminum, Tin
or Steel Cans



Containers must be empty, clean and dry!

DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES! Place items loose in same container.

Containers may not exceed 49 lbs.

DO NOT RECYCLE THESE ITEMS:

Aerosol cans • Aluminum foil • Broken glass • Clam shell containers • Dishes
Flatware • Flower pots • Frozen food boxes • Gift wrap • Hardback books
Hazardous waste • Ice cream containers • Light bulbs • Medical Waste
Mirrors • Paper plates/cups/towels • Paint cans • Pizza boxes
Plastic utensils/cups • Plastics #3-7 • Plastic bags • Pots & pans • Shredded paper
Styrofoam • Take out containers • Tissue paper • Vases • Yogurt cups

Bulky Waste: 3 items per trash day including furniture, wood waste, textiles & mattresses. Carpet must be cut into 4' lengths, rolled and tied (1 roll = 1 bulk item). No construction waste, metals, TVs or electronics.
Construction Debris: ACUA collects household renovation debris twice annually, during the Spring and Fall. Call 609-641-2832 x. 123 for details.
Metals: Northfield Spring Works collects metal on the 1st Wednesday of each month, regardless of your regular trash collection day. These items can be placed at the curb, separate from trash if it is on your trash day.
Electronics: Neither the ACUA nor Northfield Public Works collects or accepts electronics. For disposal options visit: www.acua.com/electronics
Latex Paint: Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. acua.com/paint
Rigid Plastics: Large plastic items (toys, chairs, laundry baskets, buckets) are recyclable at no charge at the ACUA's rigid plastic drop-off. acua.com/rigidplastics
Alkaline batteries: Dispose of in the trash, as they no longer contain mercury.
Rechargeable batteries: Bring to ACUA's Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off days. acua.com/hhw

YARD WASTE INFORMATION

Yard waste includes the following items:

- leaves, grass, brush, branches, clean wood, Christmas trees
- No bamboo, cornstalks, reeds, seagrass, or hay/straw bales.
- Place yard waste in kraft bags or properly marked containers. **No plastic bags.**
- Kraft bags or containers should not exceed 49 lbs.
- Brush/branches must be tied with twine.
- Brush/branches should not exceed 4' in length or 8" in diameter.
- Sector A:** Mill Road north to the Pleasantville border.
- Sector B:** Mill Road south to the Linwood border.
