SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

Please **do not** use plastic bags for your recyclables!
Place all recyclable items in the same container.
Place containers curbside by 7 a.m.
Containers may not exceed 49 lbs.

RECYCLE THESE:

- PAPER, CARDBOARD & CARTONS:**
 - juice boxes
 - newspaper
 - magazines
 - paper egg cartons
 - cardboard boxes
 - paperback books
 - shredded paper
 - cereal/food/pizza boxes
 - hardback books (no covers)
- GLASS BOTTLES & JARS**
food & beverage containers
- ALUMINUM/STEEL/TIN CANS:**
empty paint cans (remove lid) empty aerosol cans (remove cap)
- PLASTIC BOTTLES & CONTAINERS:** (no styrofoam)
food/beverage containers (maximum size 3 gallons)

DO NOT RECYCLE THESE:

- Plastic bags (return to a store)
- Light bulbs (CFLs or standard)
- Plastic utensils & drinkware
- Paper plates, towels, tissues
- Clothes hangers
- Styrofoam
- Mirrors, broken glass, vases
- Hazardous or medical waste
- Pots & pans, dishes, flatware
- Aluminum foil

Bulky Waste: Three items per trash day including furniture, wood waste, textiles, mattresses, carpet (cut to 4' lengths, rolled & tied) and other large items. No construction waste, metals, TVs or electronics.

Construction Debris: ACUA will collect household renovation debris twice annually, during the Spring and Fall. Call 609-641-2832 x. 123 for details.

Metals: Northfield Public Works collects metal on the 1st Wednesday of each month, regardless of your regular trash collection day. These items can be placed at the curb, separate from trash if it is on your trash day.

Electronics: Neither the ACUA nor Northfield Public Works collects or accepts electronics. For disposal options visit: www.acua.com/electronics

Latex Paint: Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. acua.com/paint

Rigid Plastics: Large plastic items (toys, chairs, laundry baskets, buckets) are recyclable at no charge at the ACUA's rigid plastic drop-off. acua.com/rigidplastics

Batteries: Alkaline batteries can be disposed of in the trash, as they no longer contain mercury. Rechargeable batteries can be disposed of at the Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off at ACUA. acua.com/hhw

YARD WASTE INFORMATION

Yard waste includes:

- leaves, grass, brush, branches, clean wood, Christmas trees
- No bamboo, cornstalks, reeds, seagrass, or hay/straw bales.
- No plastic bags.
- Place yard waste in kraft bags or in properly marked containers.
- Bags or containers should not exceed 49 lbs.
- Brush/branches must be tied with twine.
- Brush/branches should not exceed 4' in length or 8" in diameter.

Sector A: Mill Road north to the Pleasantville border.
Sector B: Mill Road south to the Linwood border.
