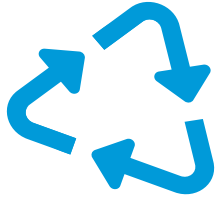

Create art from material destined for the recycling bin or trash can for the 12th Annual Recycled Art Contest!

Guidelines:

- Artwork must be made from a minimum of 75% recyclable or non-recyclable (trash) materials. Entries will be judged based on creativity, use of recycled materials, and overall presentation.
- Maximum size: 2' x 2' x 2'. All pieces must be secured. No sharp edges.
- Participants must be residents of Atlantic County.
- Categories: Ages 8 & younger; 9-13; 14-17; 18 & Older; or Group.
- Entries must be submitted at the Atlantic County Library System branches in Absecon, Brigantine, Egg Harbor City, Egg Harbor Township, Galloway Township, Hammonton, Pleasantville, Somers Point or Ventnor.
- Entries may also be submitted to Stockton University's Richard E. Bjork Library, the libraries at the Atlantic Cape Community College Mays Landing and Atlantic City campuses, the Lindwood Public Library, the Otto Bruyns Public Library of Northfield, or the Atlantic City Free Public Library.
- **Artwork with completed entry form attached must be received between Thursday, October 1 and Saturday, October 31, 2026.**
- **Entries will be displayed at Library Branches through October 31, 2026.**
- Artwork will be transported to ACUA to be entered for judging. Awards will be presented and artwork will be showcased at **ACUA's America Recycles Day Event, Saturday, November 21, 1 p.m. to 3 p.m.** (Rain Date: Sunday, November 22).
