APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES OF THE BOARD MEETING ON December 19, 2024, voted on and approved by all members.

RESOLUTION COMMENTS:

Resolution 25-1-6: Authorizing a contract amendment to contract with Kuehne Chemical Company for the Supply of Sodium Hypochlorite (15% Concentration), Bid No. 2023-WW-07. Amount is not to exceed \$736,200.00.

Explanation: The Authority is exercising the option to extend the contract for a 12-month period beginning January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2025.

Resolution 25-1-7: Authorizing a contract amendment to contract with Kuehne Chemical Company for the Supply of Sodium Hypochlorite (20% Concentration), Bid No. 2023-WW-07. Amount is not to exceed \$140,400.00.

Explanation: The Authority is exercising the option to extend the contract for a 12-month period beginning January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2025.

Chairman Embry asked what the difference is between 15% and 20% concentration. Mr. Pantalone responded stating that 15% was the concentration that Wastewater used historically, but the price went up significantly. Wastewater experimented with a higher concentration, to try and reduce the transportation costs (i.e. number of deliveries). Mr. Pantalone explained that this did not work out regarding disinfection purposes but did save money for post chlorination, which is why we have two separate contracts. He said Wastewater will use the 15% concentration for disinfection and use the 20% for post-chlorination, which has been beneficial.

Resolution 25-1-27: Authorizing payment of certain expenditures: \$7,972,396.05

Ms. Mento recused herself from the vote regarding the Retiree State Health Benefits expenses and approved all other expenditures.
