DISPOSAL INFORMATION

Bulky Waste: is collected on the same day as trash and includes furniture, mattresses, wood waste and carpet. Carpet must be cut into 4' lengths, rolled and tied (1 roll = 1 bulk item). **No electronics, televisions, construction waste or metals.**

Metals: Call Public Works for metal & appliance pick ups at 609-561-4487.

Electronics: Electronics can be dropped off at the Public Works Yard at 1461 Backline Road from 8 am until 1 pm on the 2nd Saturday of odd numbered months. ACUA does not accept electronics.

Latex Paint: Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. acua.com/paint

Batteries: Alkaline batteries can be disposed of in the trash. Rechargeable, lithium-ion, nickel-cadmium, silver-oxide and lead-acid batteries should be taken to our Household Hazardous Waste drop-off days. acua.com/hhw
