

# ACUA 2022 MARGATE Collection Services

ACUA will no longer empty drums and barrels of any size. Full container weight limit is 50 lbs. (excluding wheeled/lidded carts)

**PLACE ALL MATERIAL CURBSIDE BY 7 AM**

**RECYCLING and TRASH are collected every week on the same day.**

- ◆ All trash must be in containers.
- ◆ Loose bags will not be collected.
- ◆ Please keep trash and recycling 10 feet apart.

## Recycling & Trash Collection Zones:

**Mon:** Coolidge to Wilson, Fremont Ave. to the beach

**Tues:** Vendome to Jerome (both sides), Fulton to the beach

**Wed:** Jerome to Essex, Bayshore Dr. West to the beach

**Thurs:** Essex to Fredericksburg, from Bayshore Blvd. to the beach

**NOTE:** Collections will not be performed on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas. Check [acua.com](http://acua.com) for changes.

## DISPOSAL INFORMATION

**BULKY WASTE:** One (1) item per trash day including furniture and mattresses. Carpet must be cut into 4' lengths, rolled and tied (1 roll=1 bulk item). **No metals, construction waste, televisions or electronics.**

**ELECTRONICS:** Call Public Works to schedule a collection.

**METALS & APPLIANCES:** Call Public Works to schedule a collection.

**LATEX PAINT:** Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. [acua.com/paint](http://acua.com/paint)

**BATTERIES:** Alkaline batteries can go in the trash. Rechargeable, lithium-ion, nickel-cadmium, silver-oxide and lead-acid batteries should be taken to a Household Hazardous Waste drop-off. [acua.com/hhw](http://acua.com/hhw)

## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DROP-OFF

- See front for dates and location.
- Proof of residency is required - driver's license, tax bill, etc.
- Containers will not be returned, no exceptions. Bring items in a throwaway container (such as a cardboard box).
- Container sizes cannot exceed 5 gallons. No exceptions.
- Maximum quantity is 20 gallons and/or 200 lbs. dry weight.
