**DISPOSAL INFORMATION**

- BULKY WASTE:** 2 items per trash day including furniture, appliances, metals, 2 non-commercial tires (rims removed). Carpet must be cut into 4' lengths, rolled and tied (1 roll = 1 bulk item). *No construction waste, TVs, electronics or items containing Freon.*
- ELECTRONICS:** ACUA does not accept electronics. A drop-off is available at the BVT Public Works Yard on 1st Saturday of each month from 8 - noon. Visit [acua.com/electronics](http://acua.com/electronics) for other options.
- LATEX PAINT:** Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. [acua.com/paint](http://acua.com/paint)
- BATTERIES:** Alkaline batteries can go in the trash. Rechargeable, lithium-ion, nickel-cadmium, silver-oxide & lead-acid batteries should be taken to our Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off. [acua.com/hhw](http://acua.com/hhw)
- SHREDDED PAPER:** Cannot be recycled curbside, but can be brought to ACUA's Recycling Drop-off in EHT. [acua.com/rcdropoffs](http://acua.com/rcdropoffs)

**YARD WASTE COLLECTION**

Includes: leaves, grass, brush, branches and Christmas trees

- No bamboo, cornstalks, reeds, seagrass, or hay/straw bales.
- No plastic bags. Use kraft bags or properly marked containers.
- Kraft bags or containers should not exceed 50 lbs.
- Brush/branches must be tied with twine.
- Brush/branches must not exceed 4' in length or 8" in diameter.

**YARD WASTE IS COLLECTED IN:** Alpine Village, Buena Family Manor, Cedar Gardens, Collings Lakes, Cranberry Run, sections of Newtonville & selected areas only. *Other areas should contact BVT Public Works.*
